

DUTY OF CARE & SAFETY.

- Supervision is only given by a Coach & Manager during the teams designated training time. Before & after training is the responsibility of careers.
- Supervision at games & before & after is the responsibility of careers.
- Caregivers are please asked to have Children reframe from kicking balls on the brick retaining wall around the Sports Complex & climbing the Goal Posts these are safety issues.
- Cricket have also asked that players refrain from kicking balls or climbing the Cricket screens at either end of the fields, these are a permanent fixture & need to be maintained for future long term use.
- Please note: Shin pads must be worn at training and games this is not only a safety issue but a insurance requirement.

BLUE CARD.

Club Committee Members are required to hold a current Blue Card. It is advised that Coaches & Managers also should hold a current Blue Card if you do not please see Deb Kerkin ASAP & if anyone else wishes to apply please do.
